SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. Describe what it means that Christians are "inbetweeners." Give an example of how this reality manifests in your life.
2. What's the significance of the peoples' response to the threat of attack (cf. **vv.7-9**)?
3. In times of struggle or confusion do you tend to react by praying, or by doing something about it? How can the Christian find a healthy balance between the two?
4. Review the situation in **vv.15-23**, drawing parallels to the Christian life today.
5. How does the Word of God help the Christian to both spiritually build and fight? Give specific examples.
6. Why is Christian fellowship *vital* for your lives as "inbetweeners"? How might you better pursue this kind of fellowship?

Read Nehemiah chapter 5 in preparation for next week's sermon.
