4. What was Shemaiah's agenda (cf. v.12)? What are some agendas you perceive or have experienced in false teachers today?
5. Have you ever confused God's agenda with your own? Are you still prone to do this?
6. Describe how Jesus is the only trustworthy Prophet. How does He guard His people in truth?
7. What are some ways Christians can stand guard against the influence of false teachers?
