3. Discuss the worldly pattern of finding confidence in "self." Identify some ways you've incorporated this in your own life.
4. Read **Psalm 20:7**, and discuss some practical ways you might put your confidence in God.
5. Why was it problematic that some of the Jews wished to maintain ties with Tobiah (cf. **vv.17-19**)? How is this symbolic of your relationship with the world?
6. Identify some ties you have with the world that might be questionable/unhealthy. How can you shake them off?

Read Nehemiah 7 in preparation for next week's sermon.
