3. Have you ever felt unworthy/unprepared to receive God’s Word? Why? Were you able to overcome?
4. Receiving Scripture always prompts a response of either resistance or submission. How might either of these responses look in your life?
5. Describe from v.8, the role of a minister of Scripture. What does it mean to *exposit*?
6. What are some dangers/consequences of ministers who do not exposit?
7. What are some expectations you have when you listen to a sermon? Are these healthy expectations or not?
