### SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. What is reverence, and how is it expressed through physical posture? How did God's people show reverence for the Word of God (v.5)?
2. "Outward posture reveals inward posture." What does this mean? Give some examples.
3. What is (or *isn't*) the inward posture that one should receive Scripture with?
4. What's your attitude when reading the Bible/hearing a sermon on any given day? Why?
5. Contrast the outward postures at the end of v.5 and v.6. Discuss the distinct inward postures.
6. Why is receiving/reading the Word an act of worship? (hint: **Exodus 33:9-10**)
7. What does it mean to receive God's Word with *humility*? Is this easy or difficult for you, and why?
8. Discuss some strategies that might help you to receive the Word in surrender/submission to God.
