3. Read **v.5** and expand this in your own words. Why are *reflective prayers* lacking today?
4. Define *humility*, and discuss why/how reflective prayers leads to it.
5. Considering **vv.6-7**, describe what a prayer of *repentance* looks like.
6. What does it mean to call God to *remember* (cf. **v.8**)? How does this *embolden* prayer?
7. Lift up a "big prayer" in light of the promises of the Gospel.
