SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. In what way does every good “hero” story borrow from the Gospel? Give an example.
2. How do you see the enemy’s opposition today? (In society? In the Evangelical Church? In your own life?)
3. Review Sanballat’s jeers (v.2). What are some ways you’ve been jeered at before? Why and how was it effective?
4. How is Satan like a fox? Describe some ways Satan’s plots have discouraged you, particularly in times when you least expected.
5. In what sense is the enemy *finished*? Why is it challenging to believe this at times?
6. Describe how the Gospel deconstructs Satan’s jeers and plots. How does Christ help you stand *today* in the face of your own weakness?

Read Nehemiah chapter 4 again in preparation for next week’s sermon.
