There is an application process for all mentors / mentees. This process is necessary to ensure the quality of the mentor group. Please note: every mentoring group will consist of one mentor and one mentee barring special circumstances.

Description of Services

Mentee

Qualifications

- Member of Kansas Mission Church
- Regular participant of the College-Aged Group ("Soli Deo Gloria")
- Eagerness to learn and grow; receptive to feedback

Role

Complete the goals handout – covering academic, spiritual, and personal goals – and submit a mentee questionnaire 24 hours prior to the initial meeting. This will give the mentor a profile of the mentee in advance of the first meeting.

During meetings, the mentee should respectfully listen to any feedback and guidance received. Outside of the initial meeting, the onus should be on the mentee to keep in contact, communicate expectations or changes thereof, and ask for help when needed.

Mentor

Qualifications

- Member of Kansas Mission Church

- Considered an EM “adult” (35 years or older) to promote bringing together individuals at much different life stages.
- Must exemplify spiritual maturity (i.e. earnest in their faith and pursuit of God, without reproach both within and without the community of faith)

Role

The mentor should make the initial contact with his/her mentee. After receiving the mentee's profile and goals, the mentor should be willing to provide guidance and feedback (e.g. share their own experiences).

The mentor should be supportive, not critical or negative, but should also push their mentees to grow and mature spiritually in their faith and personal lives.

Term

The term of the mentor-mentee program is one semester. The end date will be the last day of the mentee's school semester. The term may be renewed / extended by the mentor and mentee.

Frequency of Meetings

The frequency of meetings is up to the mentor and mentee. A general rule of thumb is to meet face-to-face at least once every 4-6 weeks with some email contact in between. However, this is not a rule. Every relationship will be different based on the mentor-mentee's preferences.

Confidentiality

All things that are shared between a mentee and a mentor should be kept confidential unless prior consent is granted by either party. This provision shall continue to be effective even after the term of the mentor-mentee relationship.

Conflict Resolution

If a conflict were to arise, both mentor (who holds the initiative responsibility) and mentee should seek resolution following the principles of Matthew 18:15-17. Every effort should be made to resolve the conflict privately (i.e. between mentor and mentee). If this isn't possible, a neutral trusted third party who holds membership in the church should be involved. The final step is to bring the matter before the church leadership.
