

Kansas Mission Church Ministry Opening Description Children's Ministry Director (pre-K – 6th grade, Part-time)

We are seeking a part-time children's ministry (CM) director who will oversee the pre-K-6th grade ministry of Kansas Mission Church (KMC). We are a non-denominational, multigenerational church made up of two congregations; a first-generation Korean speaking congregation, and a second-generation English speaking congregation. The position will serve students combined from both congregations (majority English speaking). As CM director, you will oversee all ministry aspects which include teaching, planning, training, event coordinating, and administration. You will also be expected to oversee a team of teachers, as well as work directly with pastors and parents of both congregations.

The applicant will be expected to work in a team-ministry setting alongside lay leaders and teachers, and under the supervision and accountability of a senior pastor. The applicant should be willing and able to work in the context of two cultures (Korean and Korean-American), promoting unity in the Spirit amidst the multigenerational congregations existent at KMC. The applicant will be expected to contribute to the overall vision of KMC in promoting the Gospel in the lives of congregants.

The applicant should be solidly grounded in his/her faith, possessing a learned knowledge of the Scriptures and Evangelical orthodoxy. He/she should sense a call and possess both a desire and ability to minister to children.

This position is part-time, requiring commitment at church on Sundays. The applicant should also expect to be at church some weekdays for educational staff meetings. During special annual events (e.g. Vacation Bible School) the applicant will be expected to spend more time as the event calls for.

Responsibilities include:

- -Teaching for Sunday Children's Worship
- -Overseeing Sunday school curriculum
- -Partnering with pastors and parents in the spiritual formation of the children
- -Planning and overseeing teachers' meetings and PTA meetings
- -Planning and overseeing annual programs (VBS, holiday programs, etc.)
- -Coordinating and communicating regularly with parents
- -Coordinating with the PTA and its representatives
- -Coordinating with other pastors, leaders, and the education committee

Qualifications include:

- -Previous experience in children's/education ministry is preferred
- -Formal theological education is highly preferred (e.g. Seminary, Bible College)
- -Fluency in English is required, fluency in Korean is optional

Starting at \$10,000 per year (negotiable, commensurate with experience)
