1. Describe the dichotomy of *thinking vs feeling*. Which do you lean more towards? Why are both necessary in approaching Scripture?

3. How is *emotion* a healthy part of responding to the Word? What are the dangers of *emotionalism*?
4. "Emotion submits to Scripture". Describe what this means from reading **vv.10-12**.
5. What is the "joy of the LORD" (**v.10**), and how does it bring the believer *strength*?
6. In times of deep struggle, why is it difficult to cling to truth? What are some ways you might better practice this?
