SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. Recall a time in your life when you made a renewed commitment to God. What did this entail on your part? Did the commitment go well?
2. Why is it important that Israel acknowledged God first (v.6) in their covenant renewal?
3. Unpack **verse 6**, describing at least *four features* about God that make Him distinct and worthy of worship.
4. How is the depth of one's knowledge of God related to the depth of one's worship of God?
5. According to **verse 7**, what was the basis of God's choice of Abram to be the recipient of the covenant promises? Why do you think Abram was given a new name?
6. Why was it important that the Israelites acknowledged God's choice of Abraham? How is this related to God choosing you?
7. Read the last phrase of **verse 8**, explaining it and describing how this helps the Christian to commit to following God.

Read Nehemiah 9:9-38 for next week's sermon.
