## SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. What is steadfast love? Use the language of verse 17, 31 and 32 in your definition.
2. Contrast steadfast love to a "worldly" or cultural concept of what love is.
3. Describe what it means that steadfast love is covenantal. What role does emotion play in this?
4. Highlight some patterns of Israel's history of repetitive sin in vv.26-31. In what ways are you like Israel in your own habitual sin patterns?
5. What does it mean that God's love is conditional? Is God's love "unconditional" in any way?
6. How does God use suffering in the lives of those he loves? How have you experienced this?
7. How does the Gospel reconcile God's conditional love and God's covenantal love for the believer?

Read Nehemiah 9-11 for next week's sermon.
