SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. Read **Nehemiah 9:33**; what does it mean that God was "righteous" in all that had befallen Israel?
2. How was Israel "wicked"? Does this kind of wickedness persist today in the world? In your own life?
3. Consider **Nehemiah 9:35**; do you think that if God set Israel up for success and helped them, that they would have not sinned? Do you ever think this about yourself?
4. Considering today's text and also the Genesis account (especially chapters 1-6), why is there suffering in the world? Why does God allow suffering to persist?
5. Why did Jesus have to come to undo wickedness? How does Christ inform and give hope in the midst of suffering today?

Read Nehemiah 10-11 for next week's sermon.
