SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. Describe what it means that Christianity (a relationship with God) is not based on a decision, but a series of decisions.
2. What is covenant ratification, and why was it described as entering a curse and oath (v.29)?
3. Do you take your relationship with God seriously? Why or why not? Why should you?
4. Consider Israel's decision to *observe* and *do* God's commandments (v.29); why are both necessary (and impossible!) in a relationship with God? How does the Gospel inform how Christians practice this today?
5. Why did God command the Israelites not to intermarry (v.30, cf. Exodus 34:15-16)? How is this principle applied to Christians?
6. What is one *practical* way you can decide today to live out your identity as one who is in Christ?

Read Nehemiah 10:28-39 for next week's sermon. You can supplement this reading with Exodus 34-35.
