SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. In light of today's text, what purpose did it serve for Israel (and us) to remember their history?
2. **Verses 9-15** recall the story of the Exodus. In what way was this the definitive act of redemption for Israel? What did it remind them of?
3. As God's people today, what is our definitive act of redemption? How does the Exodus point forward to this? (Give examples from vv.9-15)
4. What does it mean to be "stiff-necked" (**vv.16-17**)? Share some ways that you are stiff-necked.
5. Why do you think Israel included their continued failure in their recollection of history, rather than wiping it away?
6. Find some verses that show God's continued restoration in spite of Israel's failures. How does this give you hope today (especially if you tend to dwell in the past)?

Read Nehemiah 9-11 for next week's sermon.
