SERMON FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

1. What is the Sabbath? How do you practice it today, and what influenced this practice?
2. Read **Exodus 31:12-17**, and explain why observing Sabbath was so vital for Israel. What did the Sabbath have to do with their covenant identity?
3. Should Christians practice Sabbath today? Why so? (hint: Genesis 2:1-3)
4. How might the Jews' practice of banning worldly interaction (v.31) challenge your practice of Sabbath today? Give practical examples.
5. How does the vow to forego crops and forgive debt every seven years (v.31, cf. Ex 23:10, Deut 15:1) reveal what is at the heart of the Sabbath?
6. Jesus is the fulfillment of Sabbath, the *Rest* of God's people. How did he accomplish this, and what works can you now rest from in Him?
7. Do you struggle to rest in Christ? How so?

Read Nehemiah 10:28-39 for next week's sermon. You can supplement this reading with Exodus 34-35.
