Catechism for Adults

These are adapted from the Westminster Shorter Catechism (1647).

Q.8: How does God execute his decrees?

A.: God executes his decrees in the works of creation and providence. Ps. 148:8, ISA 40:26, DAN. 4:35, ACTS 4:24-28, REV. 4:11

Catechism for Children

Q.22: In what condition did God make Adam and Eve?

He made them holy and happy.

Q.23: What covenant did God make with Adam?

The covenant of life.

Q.24: What is a covenant?

A relationship that God establishes with us and guarantees by his word.

Psalm 16 Devotional

This is a psalm about inheritance. Psalm 16:1-6 outlines the inheritance and promise of God's covenant people. Our inheritance is God Himself. This is unspeakably significant. In the formation of Israel, the Levitical tribe, who were priests, did not get an inheritance of land like the other 11 tribes of Israel, but were told that God himself was their inheritance. What was reserved for one tribe in Israel has been given to all believers in Christ. (See Num. 18:20, 1 Pet. 2:9, Rev. 1:6) Psalm 16:7-10 outlines the reason God's people must believe that God will fulfill those promises. Christ has conquered death and is our forgiveness. Because he died to atone for our sins and was raised from the dead to grant the same life to us, we can be assured that God has not given His people an empty promise. Psalm 16:11 displays the eternal result of God's promise to His people. "In your presence is fullness of joy, at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." We will see God's goodness, unhindered by our sinful hearts and fully able to enjoy Him. That is our inheritance as believers in Christ. As we live our lives this side of eternity, we must remember that anything short of seeking to enjoy God fails to connect us with our truest purpose—we were created to glorify God and fully enjoy Him forever.

Questions & Prayer:

Do you recall a time when you truly enjoyed God? What was it like? What are some things hindering you from enjoying God?

Pray: Lord, help me to understand the inheritance you have given me. Help me to love and enjoy you, to not be distracted by what seems valuable on earth but to desire to spend time with you, to honor you with my time and to want the fullness of who You made me to be.
